Position Description

UW Medicine Primary Care, in conjunction with the Department of Family Medicine, is seeking two Dyad ARNP or PA-C / Teaching Associates for primary care practices in Kent and Federal Way, WA, south of Seattle.

The Dyad APP sees approximately 10-15 patients per day. They use the rest of their time managing 1-2 provider in-baskets and providing other forms of clinical support each day. This position is open to qualified ARNP or PA-Cs.

UW Medicine has a single mission: To improve the health of the public. The 30,000 members of our community advance this mission through the excellence of their work in patient care, medical education and research.

UW Medicine Primary Care offers a complete spectrum of primary care services and is committed to improving the health of the public. The providers are actively engaged in teaching and provide care using the medical home model, creating a friendly and stimulating atmosphere for providers, staff and patients.

We prioritize unique and comprehensive care delivery to serve the needs of our patients, including behavioral health, care management, lab and radiology, and a fully integrated electronic medical record. As part of UW Medicine and University of Washington School of Medicine and the top ranked primary care training program in the United States, our employees have the distinct advantage to provide our patients with an exceptionally high level

of innovative care.

Teaching Associates hold annual appointments that align with a 12-month service period (July 1-June 30) and may be reappointed to subsequent annual terms. Faculty with 12-month service periods are paid for 11 months of service over a 12-month period (July-June), meaning the equivalent of one month is available for paid time off. In addition to providing primary care, this role will include some clinical teaching responsibilities. Position will ideally start Summer/Fall 2024.

The base salary range for this position will be \$10,122. This is inclusive of base salary provided through the UW Physicians (UWP) practice plan, in addition to base salary provided by the University. Please note that only compensation provided by the University is included in University benefit determinations and calculations. Compensation provided by UW Physicians (UWP) practice plan may provide eligibility for separate benefits offered by that organization.

Other compensation associated with this position may include one-time Monthly Additional Compensation payment and incentive pay based on performance.

Candidates must have earned an ARNP or PA-C and should be board certified. Candidates will need to possess or obtain a valid Washington State medical license and DEA cert. Experience in primary care preferred.
